Show Rules:

AOS judges will choose plants from the show for AOS judging. The rest of the plants will be ribbon judged by RSBCOS judges. Ribbon judging will be first, second, third and honorable mention. The judges decision will be final.

Orchid plants and designs may be entered Friday October 1, 2 – 4 pm and on Saturday October 2, 8 – 9:30 am.

Exhibits will be released Sunday Oct 3, at 3 pm.

Design theme : "Orchids Bright and Beautiful"

Designs must be the work of the exhibitor and must feature orchids the table covering will be black and the background will be black.

Gubler's Orchids and the Riverside/San Bernardino Counties Orchid Society are not responsible for damage or breakage of plants or design containers.

Design classes: small 3 – 12 inches, Standard 24 inches and up.

Use the entry sheets at the back of this schedule for plants and designs. You may copy the sheets and bring them to the show filled out, it will speed things up. There will be entry sheets available at the show. Fill them out in pencil. If you don't know what your orchid is fill in the rest of the information and we will attempt to help you.
