# **Ribbon Judging**

• Ribbons are awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners.

Plants entered for ribbon judging will automatically be considered to receive the awards below. <u>No separate registration required.</u>

**GRAND CHAMPION** ~ best in show, selected by a panel of judges. Recognizes the most superior orchid in the show, based upon a combination of flower quality and plant condition. Winning orchid may have a single, superior bloom or may be a notable multi-growth, multi-flowered plant.

- Best Cattleya ~ recognizes best Cattleya Alliance hybrid or species.
- Best Paphiopedilum ~ awarded to best hybrid or species Paphiopedilum.
- Best Phalaenopsis ~ may be Phalaenopsis or Doritanopsis hybrid or species.
- **Best Vanda** ~ may be Vanda, Ascocenda or other vandaceous genera such as Aerangis, Aerides, Angraecum, Rhynchostylis, Renanthera, or intergenerics.
- Best Miltonia ~ recognizes best Miltonia or Miltoniopsis.
- Best Oncidium Alliance ~ recognizes best Oncidium Alliance hybrid or species.
- **Best Dendrobium** ~ recognizes best Dendrobium hybrid or species.
- Best Cymbidium~ recognizes best Cymbidium hybrid or species.
- Best Miscellaneous Genera ~ awarded to genera not listed.
